Hello my dearest friends!

Here I am... back with new sounds as promised.

First I would like to tell you all a bit about how I am doing: I'm still feeling the same, but my illness is stabilizing a bit. It's hard to pass my days this way, but hey, no-one gets to choose life I guess. I've been using morphine-patches (Durogesic) for a while now, and I can say that the pain is getting tolerable. There are days that I don't feel much pain anymore, but then I suffer from loss of concentration. But, like always, in bad times, I put on your CDs... such beautiful music... and then, a bit drugged by the morphine, you can imagine that it's not that difficult to get to higher places. It's a feeling of total and superior calmness, when I can forget my pain and suffering... that is such a divine moment. What more could a person ask for?

As most of you have already heard, I've won a Triton Le this year by making new sounds for the MS2000. I still haven't done much with it, because most of the time I've just been listening to the preset sounds. They're not bad, but I haven't had the strength to make my own sounds. It's an ideal synth to create magnificent pads and it has 2 independent arpeggiators. That's a thing I miss in our EX5. Next year I'm going to try to make a complete bank (64) with Triton sounds for the EX5. By letting the arps of

the Triton move through each other, you can create beautiful movements into the sounds. What I also like is that you have 4 patches for each separate sound (where you can trigger the one patch to arp 1, just play patches 2 and 3, and trigger the fourth with arp 2). Can you imagine what movements you get in one sound? It's great! Heavenly music that moves through your speakers and where you can listen for minutes because of the endless changes. But not everything is good about this synth: the keyboard \$ùCKS!! I can't believe how bad it is, such a crappy keyboard for such fine synth. Shame on you KORG! Just give me my EX5 keys and I'm happy...

In September, I received another present, from my lovely wife: the Ion from Alesis, that's now standing in my brand-new studio. :-) A good VA synth, great filters, user-friendly layout, but still some work for the programmers. What's really worthwhile to notice is the reaction speed of the knobs. The filters are some of the best that I've heard. But don't think that when you are using the Moog filters that you HAVE a Moog in your studio. The difference is tiny, but you can still hear it. Real analog or virtual analog, there will always be a difference. You miss the warmth of the analog, but the virtual one is getting close...

And now, the moment you've all been waiting for, :-D a collection of Voices for your Yamaha EX5:

As promised, I have made some new sounds for you all. It's has cost me blood, sweat and tears, but I want to keep doing this as a thanks for all the support that you all have given me. I really sincerely thank you all for this. It has given me the purpose to keep on going and doing the things that I loved to do before I got ill.

64 new sounds: I guess there will be enough variety to choose from, so every one will be pleased. They are all free to be used in your own songs, anyplace, anywhere, anytime. Offered to you with much joy and pleasure... by a FRIEND! There are pads, solo sounds, some analog (VA!!) and some heavy bass sounds too. A lot of arpeggiators too, with a combination of sounds you should try out as a sequenced sound. (I've put some arps on it, so you can have a better impression about them on how they would sound as a sequenced sound).

Do not mind the names that I have given to the sounds. I find that a hard thing to do... what's a good name for a sound?? Feel free to change it to something that you may find more useful.

Don't forget to turn the knobs while browsing the sounds!

My favorites are:

003 (A03) AN BASS

012 (A12) SASH WINDOW

016 (A16) COME ONE BABY

039 (C07) BACK TO '80b

044 (C12) ONE TWO TREE

050 (D02) ENCIRCLING

053 (D05) TRY THIS ONE

057 (D09) TRIANGLE

059 (D11) LOVERS

I hope you'll enjoy these new sounds, and that they will inspire you all to create your own new sounds.

Ok, my friends, this is it for the moment, but it won't be my last that I will create for the EX5. It's my promise towards you all that I will provide new sounds each year, until my synth explodes. ;-) So... 'till next year with Triton sounds for the EX5???
